MINISTERIAL APPROVAL OF A PRODUCT STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM**

**CALL2RECYCLE CANADA, INC.**

**WHEREAS:**

- A. Batteries are prescribed products for the purposes of clause 46(a) of *The Environmental Management and Protection Act, 2010*.
- B. Pursuant to *The Household Hazardous Waste Products Stewardship Regulations* (the Regulations), no first seller shall fail to operate a Product Stewardship Program approved by the Minister of Environment; or enter into an agreement with a person to operate, on the first seller's behalf, a Product Stewardship Program approved by the Minister.

**MINISTERIAL APPROVAL** is hereby given to Call2Recycle Canada, Inc. (Call2Recycle) of Toronto, Ontario, hereinafter called the Applicant, to operate a Product Stewardship Program (PSP) in the Province of Saskatchewan in accordance with the following terms and conditions:

1. The Applicant shall operate the PSP in accordance to the proposal dated December 9, 2019, entitled Saskatchewan Product Stewardship Program Plan for Consumer Batteries;
2. The Applicant shall advise the Ministry of Environment of any change to content of the PSP upon which this approval is granted and shall obtain prior approval for any such change;
3. Under the conditions set forth in Section 8 of the Regulations, this approval may be cancelled at any time by the Minister of Environment if it is determined that the conditions of the Approval to Operate have not been properly followed.
4. The Applicant shall maintain on its corporate website ([www.call2recycle.ca](http://www.call2recycle.ca)) a current list of active first sellers conducting business in Saskatchewan. These will be identified as being members of Call2Recycle and, thereby, approved first sellers in Saskatchewan.
5. The Applicant must develop a compliance plan and procedure jointly with the Ministry of Environment. The plan shall be in place within six months of the signing date of this approval.

6. The Applicant must develop a greenhouse gas emissions measurement and management plan related to the collection and recycling of consumer batteries pursuant to clause 5(2)(m) of the Regulations. The plan shall be submitted to the Ministry of Environment within six months of the signing date of this approval for implementation in 2021 and reported in the program's 2021 annual report.
7. This approval takes effect on the date of signing.
