



E-Transport Battery Safety Tips



Follow the manufacturer's instructions for charging, storing and handling your e-transport battery.



Only use the original equipment manufacturer's charge to charge your e-transport battery.



Charge your e-transport battery plugged directly into a wall outlet. Never use charging strips or extension cords.



Never charge an e-transport battery unattended or overnight. Never leave it plugged in when it is not charging.



Avoid charging or storing your e-transport battery in extreme temperatures.



Handle your e-transport battery with care – do not drop or submerge in water.



Do not modify or attempt to repair your e-transport battery.
