

Protect what matters. Be Battery Safe. Pre-shipping - Tip Sheet

Thank you for your ongoing commitment to responsible battery management. As a Call2Recycle collection partner, you play a critical role in protecting workers, facilities, communities, and the environment by prioritizing battery safety during the pre-shipping process.

Let's work together to create a safer environment by incorporating this **Be Battery** Safe checklist into your daily operations.

Pre-Shipment Preparation: Battery Safety Checklist



Double-check Bulk Containers: Confirm that the following were properly addressed during receiving:




- All lithium-ion (Li-Ion), small sealed lead acid (SSLA), lithium, alkaline over 12V, and button/coin cells are terminally protected (bagged or taped). Refer to the terminal protection guidelines.
- No damaged/defective batteries (swollen, bloated, burn marks, cracks, leaking, or corrosion). If found, isolate and follow DDR special procedures <u>here</u>.
- No batteries exceed 5 kg unless used to power emobility devices (e-bikes, scooters, hoverboards, skateboards). Follow e-mobility battery handling procedures here.
- All non-conforming materials have been removed including industrial batteries, wet cell batteries, needles,
 bullets, vapes, electronics, other hazardous materials,
 and garbage.





Prepare for Shipment:



- Ensure your total shipment weighs at least 230 kg.
- · Securely close and seal drum lids.
- Safely place and secure shipping containers on pallet(s).
 (Note: each pallet must NOT exceed 1,135 kg).



Shipping Documents:



- Visit greentrax.call2recycle.org to get the provincialspecific shipping documents. You will need your Call2Recycle username and password. If you need assistance, please contact Tatiana Espinosa-Merlano at tespinosa-merlano@call2recycle.ca.
- · Print and complete the provided documents.
- Attach a completed copy to each container.
- Make sure all labels are visible and legible.



Schedule Shipment:
