

## PROTECT WHAT MATTERS. BE BATTERY SAFE. **E-MOBILITY BATTERY SAFETY TIPS** for e-bikes, e-scooters and hoverboards



- Follow the manufacturer's guide for charging, storing, and handling your battery.
- When buying new or replacement products or batteries, choose reputable, certified brands. Watch out for imitations.
- Don't try to modify or repair batteries yourself.
- IMMEDIATELY STOP riding with or charging an e-mobility device with a damaged (swelling, discoloration, odors, loose wires) or recalled battery.



- Use only the original charger.
- Charge directly from a wall outlet, don't use power strips or extension cords.
- Never charge your device unattended or overnight.
- Choose a cool, well-ventilated area away from exits and flammables.
- Avoid extreme temperatures while charging.
- Don't stack or cluster batteries.





- Keep your battery in a cool, dry, well-ventilated place.
- Store away from exits in case of emergency.
- Avoid extreme hot or cold temperatures.
- . Don't stack or cluster batteries.



- NEVER throw away batteries in the garbage or blue bins.
- Batteries disposed of improperly can cause fires in trash bins, waste processing facilities and landfills.
