

## UNPACK & PREPARE

### Step 1: Unpack box




Remove all contents, including bags and tape. Do not remove the Flame Retardant Liner or any of the labels from the outside of the box.

### Step 2: Bag each battery



Place each battery into one of the provided bags – one battery per bag. If bags are too small, other clear bags that fully enclose the battery may be used.

### Step 3: Place into box




Place the bagged batteries in the box. Any extra space should be filled with a non-conductive material like bubble wrap or packing peanuts.

### IMPORTANT

- ! Only one battery or device per bag.
- ! Box should weigh no more than 12kg.
- ! Recycling kit should not be used for batteries that are damaged, defective or subject to a manufacturer recall.


## SEAL & SHIP

### Step 4: Prepare to seal




Remove the tape backing from the pre-applied tape-strip on the underside of the front lid.

### Step 5: Close box



Close box by sliding the side flaps along inside of the box walls while inserting the front locking tabs into the vertical slots.

### Step 6: Seal box



Press down across the front of the mailer to secure it closed for shipping. Apply provided tape over front flap.
